

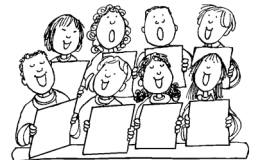
MUSIC Ministry

With the coming of Fall our music ensembles here at St. Paul resume after a well-deserved break. The following groups are groups that are always happy to have new members, and serve the members of St. Paul through music ministry. There's a place for you! (I checked...)



Glory Ringers, which rehearses 6-7 pm, rings every 4-6 weeks. Some music-reading background is helpful. We are in need of "subs" as well as ongoing members. They rehearse upstairs in the bell room/ music library except the weeks they ring, which are in the sanctuary. Glory Ringers and ensembles will resume on September 14.

Chancel Choir, which rehearses from 7:15-8:45, rehearses either in the choir room or the sanctuary, and sings most Sundays. No audition is required. The choir sings a wide variety of music, from Renaissance to the best of recent composers.
