Redbird Express Information:

- *Cost for round trip (cash only) adults \$5; ages 2 12 \$2; under 2 free
- *Buses leave (about every 5 8 minutes) beginning 2 ½ hours before game time from the water tower at St. Clair Square in Fairview Heights and if we know that we'll have more than 25 riders, we might be able to get our own bus
- *Drop off is at the corner of Clark & Broadway near Gates 5 & 6
- *The last bus leaves stadium -Clark Street between Broadway & 4th, 45 minutes after game ends
