Director of Non-Traditional Worship Service Music

Reports to:

Director of Music Ministry and Senior Pastor

Responsibilities and Duties

- Plan, in consultation with the Pastor, and lead the music for weekly non-traditional worship.
- Recruit and direct the worship band and other musicians, including weekly rehearsals.
- Plan and lead the music for special services, celebrations, concerts.
- Contribute creative ideas to musically engage our congregation and community.
- Maintain the band instruments and non-traditional music library.
- Co-ordinate with the office staff, to create worship materials such as PowerPoint.
- Attend appropriate meetings such as staff meetings.
- Report to Worship Board and Church council as needed.
- Participate occasionally in the traditional worship service.

Additional Roles Opportunities available to direct or collaborate

- Bell Choir
- Children's Choir
- Summer Youth Musical
- Fine Arts Concert Series
- Seasonal contributions to the early childhood learning center
- Contribute creative ideas for church or community musical events

Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree with professional music training and experience
- Excellent keyboard skills, including the ability to direct from the keyboard. Proficiency in any additional instrument would be a plus.
- Leadership that inspires and encourages musicians of all skill-levels
- Works well in a team environment
- Spiritual calling that elevates worship

- Part-time position, 12 hours/week. Hours include time for preparation, practicing and playing. Hours would be greater with additional roles.
