Responsibilities and Duties

- Plan, in consultation with the Pastor, and lead the music for Sunday traditional worship service.
- Recruit and direct the Chancel Choir, including weekly rehearsals.
- Recruit instrumentalists to share talents in worship.
- Plan and lead the music for special services, celebrations, concerts.
- Contribute creative ideas to musically engage our congregation and community.
- Maintain the music library
- Co-ordinate with the office staff, the creation of worship materials such as PowerPoint and the printed bulletin.
- Attend appropriate meetings such staff meetings.
- Report to Worship Board and Church Council as needed.
- Participate occasionally in non-traditional worship service.

- Fine Arts Concert Series
- Seasonal contributions to the early childhood learning center
- Contribute creative ideas for church or community musical events
