

4 Year Old Curriculum

Goals to Achieve by the Year's End Include:

- Able to identify first and last name
- Able to write 1st name, while holding pencil/crayon correctly
- Identify letters A-Z and numbers 1-20
- Count objects up to 10 and above
- Identify basic colors and shapes
- Sharing and taking turns
- Sitting and listening during carpet time and centers
- Walks in a line quietly, with hands to self
- Practices self-control
- Plays well with others
- Follows directions
- Knows letter sounds
- Recognize lower case and upper case letters
- Makes simple patterns
- Hold scissors correctly and cuts different shapes independently
- Math concepts: sequencing, ordering #'s, sizing (big to small, etc.), patterning

DAILY CURRICULUM GUIDELINES

- Manipulatives: Puzzles, Books, Playdough, Magnifying Glasses
- Free Play: Child's choice
- Art: Theme-based (individual and teacher-directed)
- Carpet Time: Calendar, Alphabet, Counting, Pledge, Theme, Student of the week, Mystery Bag
- Centers: Three theme-related activities (1 independent center and 2 teacher-directed)
- Music: Monthly songs, Holiday, Theme-based, Dancing, Movement
- Story Time (10-15 minutes)
