God bless the people of this house with love enough to spare, And help them make this house a home with bread enough to share.


We share the vision of a house for everyone in need, As, side by side, we celebrate God's love in word and deed.




## **GENESIS / CREATION** PANEL D WEST SIDE - NORTH END


THE UPPER WINDOWS DEPICT THE EARTH AND THOSE THINGS CREATED ON AND AROUND IT

THE DESCENDING DOVE SYMBOLIZES THE COMING OF THE HOLY GHOST AFTER HIS RESURRECTION






THE WAVES ARE REMINISCENT OF CHRISTS MANY MIRACLES ON THE WATERS


PANEL F WEST SIDE - 3RD FROM NORTH END


## PANEL J EAST SIDE - 3RD FROM NORTH END JESUS' BAPTISM

#### Rodney M Winfield 1925 – 2017 (aged 92)



Rodney Winfield was an American designer and artist based in St. Louis. He designed mostly stained glass as well as silver and brass repoussé, and was notably one of the first to use three dimensions in his stained glass design. He moved to St. Louis in 1953 and was a Professor of Art at Maryville University from 1964 to 1990. He designed works almost exclusively for religious institutions, he himself not religious. Winfield

married and had four children, three of whom went on to be artists themselves. Notable work: Space Window, "Scientists and Technicians Window", at Washington National Cathedral in Washington, D.C. It contains a basalt Moon rock, weighing 7.18 grams. The window was dedicated by the crew of Apollo 11, Neil Armstron, Buzz Aldrin, and Michael Collins. The Space Window contains the only Moon rock given to a non-government agency.
